

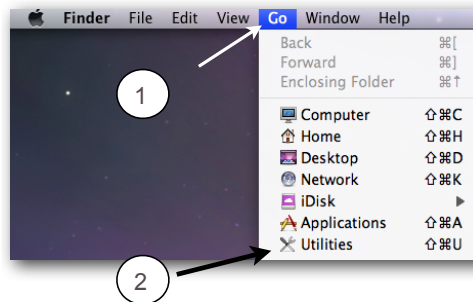
Repairing Disk Permissions

If your computer is running slower than usual, or you are having trouble opening documents or applications, the user permissions for some of your files may have become corrupted. These problems with "permissions" can happen sometimes after running Software Update or installing new software. When they do, you can repair them with Disk Utility.

First, quit all open applications, then follow these steps.

1 - In the Finder select "Go" from the menu bar.



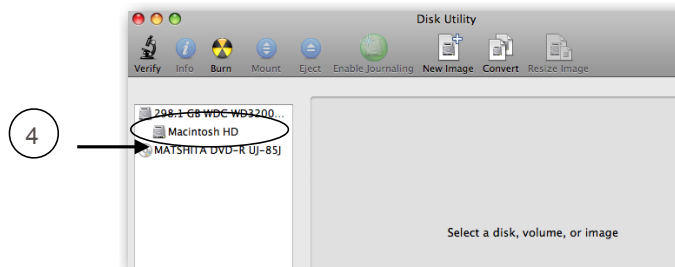
2 - Click once on "Utilities" to open it.

3 - Double-click on "Disk Utility", to open it.



Tip: Having an issue? Something not working right? Repair Disk Permissions first to see if this will resolve it.

4 - Click on the Hard Drive icon or name.



Tip: Repair Disk Permissions at least once a month, also before and after Software Updates or installing new applications.

5 - Make sure "First Aid" is selected. (the area around the words should be blue.)
